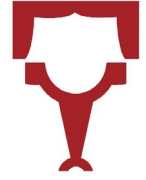


THE CHANTRY CENTRE

VISITOR CODE OF CONDUCT



At the Chantry Centre we are committed to providing a safe and friendly environment for all members of the community. We ask all visitors to follow our Code of Conduct:

- We expect all visitors to **behave in an appropriate manner**. Please speak and act respectfully to our members of staff, volunteers and other visitors.
- Our **volunteers are here to help**; remember they are not trained to provide specialist advice.
- Use of inappropriate language is not acceptable.
- Please treat staff and other visitors with respect regardless of ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, age, financial situation, gender or ability.
- **Children must be accompanied at all times** by a responsible adult. For supervised activity sessions the activity co-ordinator shall be the responsible adult.
- Inappropriate use of our WIFI and/or digital equipment is not allowed.
- Neither **Smoking or Vaping** are permitted in the building or immediately outside.
- We will not accept any drugs being brought into the building. We will ask you to leave if we believe you to be under the influence of either drugs or alcohol.
- Please familiarise yourself with the fire evacuation plan for the building.

Visitors who do not respect the Code of Conduct will, in the first instance, be given a warning. Continued breaches of the Code of Conduct may result with the individual being asked to leave the Chantry Centre.
